PLAN FOR ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT

The Platte Canyon School District has conducted an extensive inspection and evaluation of asbestos containing materials in its buildings. The original inspection/evaluation was performed in 1988 and significant updates were performed in 2004/2005. New buildings were also brought into our asbestos management program. The results of this work establish the basis for our plans to control or remove asbestos from District buildings. This work also maintains our compliance with the Federal 1986 Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act.

The results of the inspections and evaluations have been summarized in an asbestos management plan for the District. A School Asbestos Management Plan is on file at each school. The School Plans are also on file at the District Office along with a Plan for the District Complex. You are welcome to view any or all of the plans at any time during regular business hours.

All administrators, custodians, maintenance staff and technology services staff shall participate in annual asbestos information training.

No facility repairs, removal of materials (tiles, carpet) or demolition (walls, sinks) may occur without review and consent by Maintenance Director Eliot Mansk.

Each contractor completing repairs, additions or maintenance projects within the District including computer network, telephone and utility workers shall contact the Maintenance Director Eliot Mansk to review Asbestos Management Plans for facilities in which the project is being completed prior to the initiation of any work.
