

The Colorado School Entrance and Immunization Law requires all students to provide proof of immunizations to attend school. Please provide your child's immunization record before the first day of school.

School Immunization Requirements 2009-2010

Kindergarten through 2nd Grade

NEW



DTaP/DTP/Td	5 doses	(4 acceptable if 4 th dose given after 4 th b'day)
Polio	4 doses	(3 acceptable if 3 rd dose given after 4 th b'day)
Hepatitis B	3 doses	
MMR	2 doses	(1 st dose must be given > 12 mo of age for child))
Varicella	2 doses	OR History of disease documented on immunization record from doctor's office or lab confirmation

Grades 3 through 5

DTaP/DTP/Td	5 doses	(4 acceptable if 4 th dose given after 4 th b'day)
Polio	4 doses	(3 acceptable if 3 rd dose given after 4 th b'day)
Hepatitis B	3 doses	
MMR	2 doses	(1 st dose must be given >12mo of age for child)
Varicella	1 dose	OR History of disease (provide date), 2 doses may be recommended

Grades 6 through 8

NEW



DTaP/DPT/Td	5 doses	(4 acceptable if 4 th dose given after 4 th b'day)
Tdap	1 dose	(required instead of Td)
Polio	4 doses	(3 acceptable if 3 rd given after 4 th b'day)
Hepatitis B	3 doses	(could be compliant with 2 doses if started with the adult dose of Hep B age 11-15)
MMR	2 doses	(1 st dose must be given > 12mo of age for child)
Varicella	1 dose	OR History of disease (provide date), 2 doses may be recommended
Menningococcal	1 dose	recommended for people 11-18 years of age

Grades 9 through 12th

DTaP/DTP/Td	5 doses	(4 acceptable if 4 th dose given after 4 th b'day)
* Tdap	1 dose	(required for grades 10-12, instead of Td)
Polio	4 doses	(3 acceptable if 3 rd dose given after 4 th b'day)
Hepatitis B	3 doses	(could be compliant with 2doses, if started with the adult dose of Hep B age 11-15 yr olds, must indicate)
MMR	2 doses	(1 st MMR dose must have been given when child \geq 12mo)
*Varicella	1 dose	OR History of disease (provide date), 2 doses may be recommended
Menningoccal	1 dose	recommended for people 11-18 years of age

The Hep B vaccine is a series of 2-3 doses given at specific time frames. If you receive a letter of noncompliance of the Hep B series your doses may have been given at incorrect intervals. Your child will need a 4th dose of the Hep B vaccine for maximum protection from this disease.
