SCHOOL DISTRICT ORGANIZATION

POLICY 101

ARTICLE 1 NAME AND STATUS

- A. The legal name of the School District is "Platte Canyon School District, Park County, RE 1".
- B. The District is a body corporate with perpetual existence, that may hold property, sue and be sued, and be a party to contracts for any purpose authorized by law.
- C. The District is governed by the laws of Colorado, rules of the State Board of Education, and by-laws and policies adopted by the Board of Education. If the Laws of the State of Colorado and the by-laws or policies are in conflict, the Laws of Colorado govern.

ARTICLE 2 DESCRIPTION

- A. The Platte Canyon School District was consolidated in 1949. It encompasses approximately the northeastern third of Park County and includes 345 square miles, or 15 percent of the land area of Park County. Approximately 85 percent of the District is within National Forest boundaries. Following U.S. Highway 285 from Denver, the District's boundary begins at Pine Junction and ends at the top of Kenosha Pass. The District includes the communities of Bailey, Shawnee and Grant.
- B. The District consists of all territory within Park County, Colorado north of a line described as follows (all townships are south of the 40 degree base line and all ranges are west of the 6th principal meridian):
 - 1. Beginning on the W boundary line of Park County at the point where it is intersected by the S line of Sec. 33, T. 6S, R. 76W;
 - 2. Thence east to the SW corner of Sec. 36, T. 6S, R. 76W;
 - 3. Thence south to the SW corner of Sec. 12, T. 7S, R. 76W;
 - 4. Thence east to the SW corner of Sec. 9, T. 7S, R.75W;
 - 5. Thence south to the SW corner of Sec. 16, T. 7S, R.75W;
 - 6. Thence east to the SE corner of said Sec. 16, T. 7S, R. 75W;
 - 7. Thence south to the SW corner of Sec. 22, T. 7S, R. 75W;
 - 8. Thence east to the SE corner of said Sec. 22, T. 7S, R.75W;
 - 9. Thence south to the SW corner of Sec. 26, T. 7S, R. 75W;
 - 10. Thence east to the SE corner of Sec. 30, T. 7S, R. 74W;
 - 11. Thence north to the NE corner of said Sec. 30, T. 7S, R. 74W;
 - 12. Thence east to the SE corner of Sec. 22, T. 7S, R. 74W;
 - 13. Thence south to the SW corner of Sec. 35, T. 7S, R. 74W;
 - 14. Thence east to the SE corner of Sec. 36, T. 7S, R. 74W;
 - 15. Thence south to the SW corner of Sec. 7, T. 8S, R. 73W;
 - 16. Thence east to the SE corner of Sec. 8, T. 8S, R. 73W;
 - 17. Thence south to the SW corner of Sec. 16, T. 8S, R. 73W;
 - 18. Thence east to the NW corner of Sec. 23, T. 8S, R. 73W;
 - 19. Thence south to the SW corner of said Sec. 23, T. 8S, R. 73W;
 - 20. Thence east to the NW corner of Sec. 30, T. 8S, R. 72W;
 - 21. Thence south to the SW corner of said Sec. 30, T. 8S, R.72W;
 - 22. Thence east to the E boundary line of Park County at its intersection with the S line of Sec. 25, T. 8S, R. 72W.
